This individual will be responsible for teaching the Physical Education classes for our Central Christian students (3K-6th) including the implementation of a developmentally appropriate curriculum and program that promotes the spiritual, physical, cognitive and and social/emotional development of students. This individual will also be responsible in organizing the registration, coaching and management of the school's extracurricular sports' teams for the school year. Preference will be given to candidates with a demonstrated commitment to excellence in education through collaboration, effective communication, organization and a experience with curriculum development.

Teaching Responsibility

- Establishes grade-level goals, prepares and implements lesson plans, and articulates curriculum at specific developmental level.
- Sets up and organizes class activities, selecting appropriate equipment and pairings of students.
- Observes and evaluates pupils' work to determine progress, make suggestions for improvement that support individual growth, conferring with student, parent, and counselor to resolve student problems.
- Understands the preschool/elementary child, holds high expectations for all students and sees themselves as a facilitator of student learning.
- Organizes and uses a variety of teaching techniques, strategies, materials, and technology to maximize the learning of each child, both individually and in group settings.
- Demonstrates an understanding of how knowledge in their subject area is created, organized and linked to other disciplines and life experiences.
- Keeps abreast of current developments in their field and continues to deepen their understanding of their discipline(s).
- Assumes responsibility for the effective functioning of the school to include necessary non-instructional assignments and student management throughout the entire building.
- Oversees all aspects of the athletic programs that are sponsored by the school. This includes registering students, recruiting coaches, organizing practice and game schedules, ordering equipment for teams, and other duties as they arise.
- Providing guidance and direction for the school's sports program

- Demonstrates a respectful, cooperative, and caring manner with students and adults in the school community.
- Has proven ability to build positive relationships with all students, and will have strong foundational knowledge of best teaching practices for preschool and elementary aged students.
